

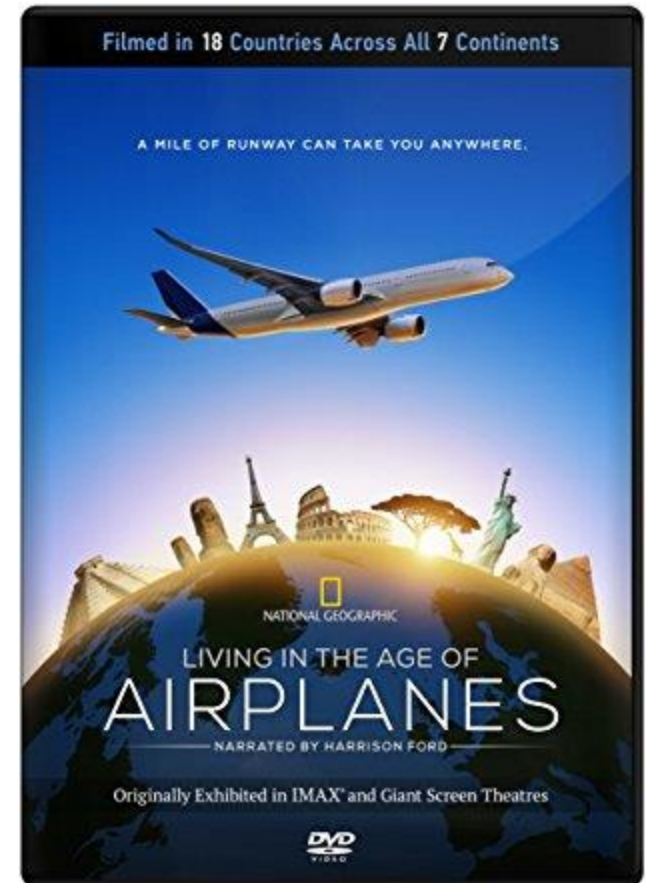

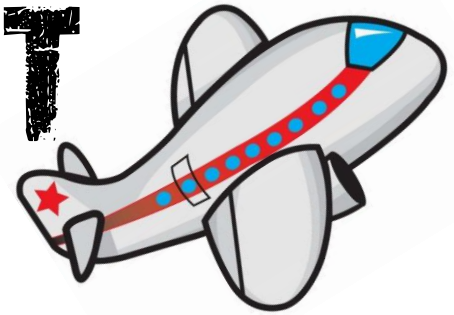
GEOGRAPHIC THEME:

MOVEMENT

- The theme movement addresses this question:
