

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

GEOGRAPHIC THEME:

MOVEMENT

- The theme movement addresses this question:
- How and why are places connected with one another?
- Relationships between people in different places are shaped by the constant movement of people, ideas, materials, and physical systems such as wind.
- Our world is in constant motion, constantly changing. Like blood flowing through our bodies, movement brings life to a place.
- What examples of movement of people, goods, or ideas do you see in your area?
- Has immigration had an impact on your area? If so, what has happened?
- What are the transportation routes in your area?
